Re: SAFIR-S

Thank you for the completed Amateur Satellite Frequency Coordination request. I now have had the opportunity to review your request with the Advisory Panel. The panel recommends that you use 2401.9 MHz and not the requested 2405 MHz. I trust that this will not create a problem for your team. If it does, please do not hesitate to contact me again.

I have noted that the launch is during August 2005 and that your mission will last for approximately 2 months. Please advise me of any delays in launch. I would also be interested in receiving a brief report from you after the launch of how the project is progressing.

We will maintain record of the coordination until November 2005. It is very important to keep me informed of any delays or other problems to ensure that we don't coordinate another project on the same frequency which may cause interference.
